RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Eligibility:** The Dare to Compete Early Bird Registration Draw (the “Draw”) is open to legal residents of Canada, excluding Quebec, who are 19 years of age or older at the time of entry. Partners, sponsors, suppliers, employees and their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) are not eligible to participate or win. Void where prohibited or restricted by law, rule or regulation. This Draw is subject to all applicable, provincial, local laws, rules and regulations.
- 2. Contest Period:** Draw ends on Friday, January 31, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (CST) (hereafter “Promotion Period”).

Additional entries received from the same person or email address in excess of the stated limitation will be void. The use of script, macro or automated devices (or any other devices intended to automate or subvert any aspect of entry) to enter the Draw is prohibited and any entry through such means and any entry that is deemed to be ineligible (at CME Manitoba’s sole discretion and in accordance with these Official Rules) are void. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of an entrant based on the email address submitted, entry will be awarded to the person named on the applicable entry (regardless of whether that is the name of the authorized account holder of the email address from which said entry form was submitted), provided such individual is eligible according to these Official Rules. Released Parties are not responsible for late, lost, stolen, incomplete, misdirected, delayed, garbled, inaccurate, or undelivered entries, or for telephonic, human or computer failures, problems or errors, interruptions in service due to system upgrades, repairs, modifications or other causes, failures or malfunctions of connections, satellite, network, cable, Internet Service Provider (ISP), phones, phone lines or telephone systems, traffic congestion on the internet, technical or mechanical malfunctions, or other malfunctions or errors, whether caused by equipment, programming, human error or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Draw, including, without limitation, errors which may occur in connection with the administration of the Draw, the processing of entries or the announcement of the prize; or for any injury or damage to participant’s or any other person’s computer relating to or resulting from participation in this Draw, or for printing, typographical, human or other errors appearing in these Official Rules or other Draw-related materials. If a potential winner cannot be contacted within 3 business days; is ineligible according to these Official Rules; fails to return the required documents within the specified time period, if prize notification is returned as undeliverable; if a potential winner decides to decline his/her prize for any reason whatsoever; or if a potential winner otherwise fails to fully comply with these Official Rules, he/she will forfeit his/her prize and the prize may be awarded to an alternate winner (time permitting) from among all remaining eligible entries received, in CME Manitoba's sole discretion.
