THE DETAILS: HOW IT WORKS

The diagnostic includes engagement from all levels of the business to get a clear picture of the organization's structure and processes. By identifying challenges and opportunities throughout the process, we can help you make significant positive impacts on your business processes while mitigating workflow and financial risks.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

To participate, your company must be a current Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters member and be in good standing with the Governments of Newfoundland and Labrador and Canada.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

The Provincial and Federal governments provide significant funding to offset the costs of the Manufacturing Productivity Program (MPP) for our members. Each company's MPP journey is unique, and as an active member, your company will only pay \$150+HST per day based on services rendered (invoices will be issued monthly by CME).

HOW MUCH TIME IS INVOLVED?

Guided by MPP's Steering Committee, your assigned LEAN Facilitator will assess your company's LEAN improvement potential by completing a comprehensive Manufacturing Productivity Diagnostic. The diagnostic will provide an initial road map outlining the recommended modules, a comprehensive implementation plan, and an estimate of how many days individuals will require hands-on 'learn-by-doing' shop-floor training based on your company's specific needs.

WHEN WOULD TRAINING BEGIN?

We realize that scheduling flexibility is vital for every business. That's why your LEAN Facilitator will work with you to negotiate the dates and timelines based on your business requirements. Timelines will be set no more than one month in advance by each company's executive and assigned LEAN Facilitator.
